Common Core Warnings

According to a noted authority, “Common Core is the latest effort by the progressive, autocratic elite bureaucrats to completely transfer all decisions concerning children from parents, teachers, and school boards to the Federal Government.” Donna Hearne, author of *The Long War & Common Core*, points out that the implementation of Common Core will completely transform America from a nation of responsible, moral, and independent human beings endowed by their Creator with the unalienable rights of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness to robots and servants of the state.

knowledge, the goals of a Common Core education focuses on values clarification and indoctrination into a liberal mindset that includes the sexualization of students through sex education and the normalization of inappropriate sexual literature.

Some of the goals of the group behind the Common Core liberal agenda include: the creation of racism offenses, teaching homosexuality as normal behavior to children, acceptance of a liberal immigration policy designed to destroy identity, and the encouragement of the breakdown of the family. “America’s Last Chance”

On the eve of the Iowa caucuses, Senator Jeff Sessions (R-AL) gave a round of interviews declaring that 2016 “is the last chance for the American people to take back control of their government.”

“This election is different because we have pell mell erosion of law, the constitutional order, where President Obama has pushed an agenda that eviscerates the immigration legal system, and pushed this trade agreement that will commence decades of transferring American economic power to an ever-expanding international commission. It’s just not going to stop.”

“This is the way the European Union began,” he added. Daily news reports are now vividly describing how the EU is disintegrating, making Americans mighty glad we never joined any proposed North American Union.

Our nation’s sovereignty depends on control of both immigration and trade, and that’s why Senator Sessions urges voters to choose a candidate who promises to kill the Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP) trade deal with nearly a dozen Asian nations. A new study by economists at Tufts University predicts that U.S. ratification of the TPP would shrink our GDP by \$100 billion, leading to a loss of 448,000 American jobs.

“This election will be the last chance for Americans to get control of their government,” said Sessions, after 30 years of promises to end illegal immigration. “I think this election is the big one.

“To win, Republicans need to demonstrate that they care about the average person who goes to work every day,” he added. Average Americans are tired of paying billions in welfare handouts to immigrants who are undermining U.S. wages.

“People should have total confidence and a clear commitment

on those issues. If they don’t, then they don’t have my vote,” he said.

The importance of Sessions’ statements on key issues in the presidential race, especially immigration and TPP, should not be underestimated. Sessions warned that, if the next president approves the TPP, it would put our trade with Asia under a powerful international commission on which the United States would have just one vote.

Our immigration policy has been anti-American, decade after decade, and the voters need to know that 2016 might be our last chance to elect a president who can reduce this tide of illegals crossing our borders. The interests of working Americans, their jobs, their wages, their hospitals, their schools, and the public safety must “be put first,” Sessions urged.

“We need a president with the credibility to tell the world that the time of illegality is over. Do not come to this country unlawfully,” he said.

“Make sure—because this could be the last chance—that the vote you cast is for a person who is going to, with courage and steadfastness, fix the immigration system that’s so broken and is impacting adversely Americans’ safety, their wages, their hospitals, their schools, those kind of things,” Sessions said.

“And also we need to know with absolute clarity: are you for or against the Trans-Pacific Partnership,” he added. “It must not pass.”

“This may be the last opportunity the American people will have to have their will imposed and create a lawful immigration system that serves the national interest,” Sessions emphasized. “I know we have to talk about the economy, national security, and the military, and the budget, and it’s hard to know who’s got the best idea,” Sessions said.

“But on these two issues [immigration and TPP], I think the voters should say, ‘If you’re not going to be right on those, I’m not voting for you in this primary and I’m not going to vote for you as president.’ I really think it’s that important.”

A History Lesson On Socialism

After the Pilgrims landed in 1620, they decided that they would plant a community garden and share the fruits and vegetables equally at the end of the season. The idea was that all would work together and share equally at the end of the season. However, no one wanted to work in the gardens. Most were reluctant to do the planting and weed a garden that was not theirs. That first year, the gardens were not well kept and they had poor crops, which led to hunger the next winter. Under this system, by

1623 the colony was facing starvation. It was decided that a new system be used the following year. Each family was given a plot of

land to garden in proportion to its size. They would be allowed to keep the fruits and vegetables for themselves.

Governor William Bradford’s account...

“This had very good success, for it made all hands industrious, so as much more corn was planted than otherwise would have been by any means the Governor or any other could use, and saved him a great deal of trouble, and gave far better content. The women now went willingly into the field, and took their little ones with them to set corn; which before would allege weakness and inability; whom to have compelled would have been thought great tyranny and oppression.”

The lesson here seems to be, when you own it you take care of it. If it belongs to someone else, you won’t take interest in it or care for it. The Pilgrims started out with socialism for the first two years but abandoned it in favor for capitalism after two years, which worked much better.

Amarillo Has Highest Number of Syrian Refugees In U.S.

Amarillo is now home to more than 1,000 refugees from the Middle East, giving the city the highest ratio of refugees in the nation, according to Watchdog.org's Kevin Ward. This has created problems for city and school officials. "Hospitals, welfare, police, you name it, are strained. That all comes back on our city budget," said city activist William Sumerford. Mayor Paul Harpole agreed. "We have 660 (refugee) kids who don't speak English and the U.S. Department of Education says they have to be at grade level within one year," the mayor said. "It's a ludicrous requirement—they don't even know how to use the bathroom." City officials are working on a plan to halt the placement of these refugees in their community. "We've been a giving community, and it's a huge disservice to bring in refugees in numbers that we're not able to handle," said Mayor Harpole. Governor Greg Abbott has called on the President to stop the importation of Syrian refugees into the U.S., citing security concerns about the federal government's ability to effectively screen the refugees. But federal courts have so far denied the request.

Texas Supreme Court Rules in Favor of Kountze Cheerleaders

In an 8-0 decision, the Texas Supreme Court issued a crucial decision in favor of the Kountze Cheerleaders, whose legal struggle began in 2012 when school officials opposed their right to paint Bible verses on sports banners. The Supreme Court overturned a 2014 Texas court of appeals decision that had ruled the case "moot," a decision which denied the cheerleaders the opportunity to defend their right to free speech and religious expression. The Justices ordered the Beaumont Court of Appeals to reconsider the case. "This is victory for the free speech and religious liberty rights of all Texas students," says Kelly Shackelford, President of Liberty Institute. "We look forward to defending the Kountze cheerleaders at the Court of Appeals and resolving this case permanently in the cheerleaders' favor."
