- #4 Support motion to adopt the conference committee report on SB 5, voter ID proof and criminal penalties, signed by Gov. Abbott
- #5 Support final passage SB 7, relating to improper relationships between teachers and students ("Passing the Trash"), signed by Gov.
- #6 Support motion to concur with House amendments to SB 8, prohibiting certain abortions and disposing of fetal remains, signed by Gov.
- #7 Support final passage SB 13, prohibiting automatic union dues from payroll deductions; left in House committee
- #8 Support final passage SB 14, comprehensive ethics reform; left in House

- #40** Oppose HB 3859, Amendment #6 includes “sexual orientation” and “gender identity” to rights for child welfare providers, bill signed by Gov.
- #41** Support final passage by voice vote HB 4034, voter registration information, signed by Gov.
- #42** Support motion to concur with SB 11 House amendments in special session (ss), patient protection on DNR orders, signed by Gov.
