SB 2 Support the conference committee report on property tax reform; signed by Gov.

SB 9 Support final passage of committee substitute on election integrity; bill died in the House.

SB 10 Oppose the creation of a mental health consortium; signed by Gov.

SB 11 Oppose the adoption of conference committee report promoting mental health in public schools; signed by Gov.

SB 17 Support final passage of bill relating to discrimination of an applicant applying for an occupational license; died in House State Affairs committee.

SB 18 Support to adopt conference committee report on protecting free speech on college campuses; signed by Gov.

SB 20 Support conference committee report on investigation, prosecution and penalties for prostitution and trafficking of person; signed by Gov.

SB 22 Support House amendment protecting taxpayers from supporting abortion providers; signed by Gov.

SB 23 Support final passage of Born Alive Infant Protection Act; left in House Judiciary & Civil Jurisprudence Committee.

SB 24 Support final passage of committee substitute providing informational materials to pregnant woman before an abortion; signed by Gov.

SB 27 Support final passage of committee substitute relating to recovering costs of frivolous claims by state agencies; signed by Gov.

SB 29 Support final passage of committee substitute banning the use of taxpayer money for lobbying; failed in the House.

SB 37 Support final passage of committee substitute relating to default on student loans as reason to refuse an occupational license; signed by Gov.

SB 129 Oppose the final passage of committee substitute which exempted ad valorem tax on home of surviving spouse of 1st responders; left in House Calendars Committee.

SB 205 Support passage of committee substitute relating to using information of non-citizens or non-residents to excuse or disqualify from jury duty; left in House Calendars Committee.

SB 475 Support the passage of House amendment to secure the electric grid; signed by Gov.

SR 535 Support Senate Resolution requesting Congress to adopt a budget to secure the border; report enrolled.

SB 691 Oppose final passage of committee substitute amending current law regarding suspension of driver's licenses for misdemeanor marijuana possession; died in House Calendars Committee.

SB 784 Support final passage of committee substitute regarding requirements for sex ed in public schools; left in House Public Health Committee.

SB 901 Support final passage relating to election integrity; died in House.

SB 903 Support final passage relating to election integrity, increasing civil and criminal penalties; died in House.

SB 933 Support final passage of committee substitute creating an office of Inspector General at the Texas Education Agency; failed in House.

SB 1048 Support final passage requiring Texas ISDs to hold school board elections in Nov. to prevent voter fatigue; left pending in House committee.

SB1257 Support voice vote on human trafficking; bill passed both Senate and House, but the Senate did not concur with House amendments, and the bill was withdrawn.

SB 1569 Support committee substitute as amended to ban school boards using taxpayer money to advocate for candidates or parties; left in House Elections Committee.

SB 1891 Support final passage limiting government growth; left in House Appropriations Committee.

SB 1978 Support House amendment #1 to “Chick-Fil-A” bill; signed by Gov.

SB 2089 Support final passage on advanced directives or treatment decisions made by or on behalf of patients; died in House Calendars Committee.

HB 1 Oppose conference committee report on general appropriations; signed by Gov.

HB 16 Support final passage of committee substitute on Born Alive Infant Protection Act; sent to Gov.

HB 18 Oppose bill requiring mental health training for public school employees; signed by Gov.

HB 19 Oppose final passage of committee substitute on mental health and substance use resources; signed by Gov.

HB 234 Support conference committee report voice vote legalizing lemonade stands run by minors; signed by Gov.

HB 253 Oppose voice vote addressing postpartum depression; sent to Gov.

HB 268 Support voice vote relating to the use of audio or visual materials in political advertising; signed by Gov.

HB 347 Support final passage on consent annexation requirements; signed by Gov.

HB 793 Support final passage of bill regarding companies with government contracts who boycott Israel; signed by Gov.

HB 852 Support final passage regarding the amount of certain permits and inspection fees; signed by Gov.

HB 1313 Support adoption of conference committee report on property tax reform; signed by Gov.

HB 1342 Support voice vote relating to eligibility for an occupational license; signed by Gov.

HB 1343 Support final passage of bill relating to criminal offenses of improper contact with a crime victim; signed by Gov.

HB 1631 Support final passage of outlawing red light cameras; signed by Gov.

HB 1802 Support final passage of filing a request for binding arbitration of certain review boards; signed by Gov.

HB 2271 Support voice vote granting the attorney general to use 2% of Choose Life license plate funds to advertise; signed by Gov.

HCR 35 Support House Committee Resolution recognizing human trafficking as a public health issue; signed by Gov.
