

To Remove Tolls Once The Road Is Paid For Resolution

Whereas, the Texas Constitution Art. 1, Sec. 26 prohibits perpetuities; and

Whereas, none of the current toll roads operating in Texas are required to take the toll off the road when the bond debt is paid off ; and

Whereas, toll agencies financially co-mingle the revenues and debt of one project with another to combine them into a 'system,' and continually extend their system and/or refinance the bond debt, hence extending the pay-off date to ensure no road is 'paid off';

Now, therefore, be it:

Resolved, that we urge the Texas Legislature to end this abuse of taxpayers and remove the toll from the highway once the initial bond debt is repaid; and therefore be it,

Resolved, we call upon the Texas legislature to pass legislation that ends system financing and perpetual tolling, and to make passage a legislative priority.
